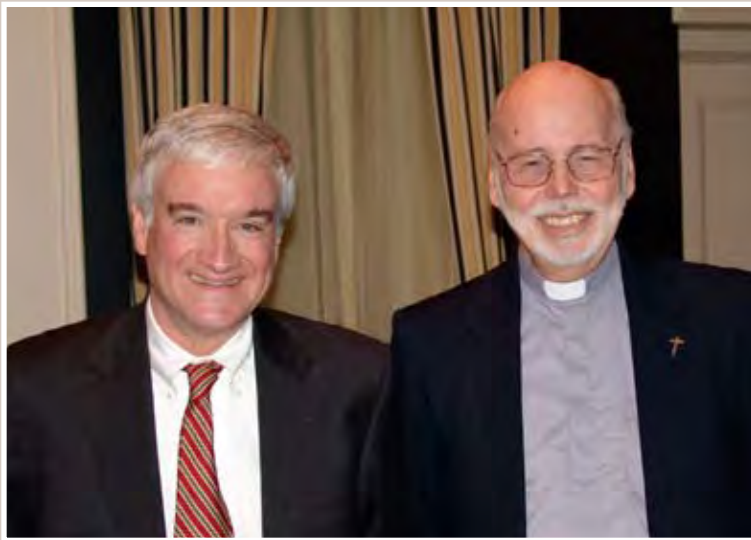

Richard Clark and Fr. Charlton enjoy the news of the great progress in national testing that St. Al's students have made despite not having science labs and equipment.



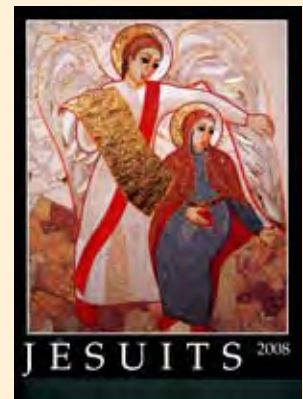
